SPIC resumes commercial production of Urea and Ammonia as per planned schedule. All its plants have re-started operations successfully.

SPIC has resumed commercial production of Urea at 11.45 A.M. and Ammonia at 7.30 P.M. on 3rd November 2019, in its plants in Tuticorin, Tamil Nadu. For both Urea and Ammonia plants, the production is expected to return to full capacity in the next few days.

The plants were shut down by the management as per schedule for regular maintenance and up-gradation work, and replacement of the Urea reactor about a month ago. Stamicarbon, Netherlands, the world leader in the design and development of urea plants for the fertiliser industry supplied the new urea reactor.

After the successful dismantling of the old reactor, the erection of the new reactor was done smoothly with due safety of the plant & equipment, environment and the workers. A thorough quality check for the new urea reactor and other maintenance work was completed before commencing commercial production.
